Dear Sir;

On the 5th April Her Majesty The Queen instructed Mrs Sonia Bonici, Senior Correspondence Officer to forward my letter to your good self the Right Honourable Tony Blair.

As to date I have not received any comment from you, now I'm use to being ignored but I didn't know that Her Majesty was. (Copy of letter from Sonia Bonici enclosed).

Now there seems to be some misunderstanding about the **PINGAT JASA MALAYSIA MEDAL (PJM)**.

So here are some facts that I hope will give you a better understanding of this Medal.

FACT. There is no British Medal that covers the same time scale as the PJM.

FACT. There is no British Medal that covers the same territory as the PJM. (Labuan Island just to name one).

FACT. It was a Commonwealth Force that served in the Emergency, The Confrontation and the period in between.

FACT. Malaysia is a Commonwealth Country giving a Medal to its Commonwealth colleagues.

FACT. **No British Citizen needs the permission from HM the Queen or the Government to accept a foreign medal if it is not to be worn.**

FACT. There is no law/rule that has been passed by Parliament that says "you can accept a foreign medal but not formally wear it".....So this ruling is unlawful. It discriminates against British Citizens. It is also racial discrimination because Malay's & Singapore Chinese who served in the British Forces and come under our MOD ruling, so this Government is stopping them from wearing the PJM even though they live in Malaysia & Singapore.

FACT. When you take ALL of the above into account the Honours Committee have acted unlawfully and have ill advised HM the Queen who indirectly has also acted unlawfully on the advice of Her Ministers.
